Panels angled to **minimise impact on aviation and sensitive receptors**

New native hedging along Reepham Road to provide screening

Land under and around solar panels to be a mix of **sheep grazing** and **wildflower meadow**

Hedging will be gapped with native species

Removal of land from intensive agriculture will **allow soils to naturally regenerate**

Space left for **biodiversity**

New wood piles as refugia for reptiles and amphibians, positioned close to water sources.

Solar panels and equipment are **positioned low to the ground** to minimise visibility from surrounding areas

Provision of **plots for breeding birds**

Existing hedging along Holly Lane will screen the site

Wildlife gates installed strategically along the fenceline adjacent to existing ditches, site corners and access gates
